

 3. to issue information or instructions containing the following statement: "The technical content of this document is approved under the authority of DOA ref. EASA.21J.016";

4. to approve minor revisions to the aircraft flight manual and supplements, and issue such revisions containing the following statement: "Revision No [YY] to AFM (or supplement) ref. [ZZ], is approved under the authority of DOA ref. EASA.21J.016";
